1 Cor. 3:10-11

MODEL, ASSIST, WATCH & LEAVE – 4 GENERATION! – 2 Tm.2:2

- 1) God is good, loving and righteous. When He created the world, it was good.
- 2) When Adam & Eve chose to listen to Satan's word instead of God's, evil and suffering began.
- 3) We cannot help ourselves escape Satan's power or change our evil desires.
  - a) God still loves us so He gave a promise. – Gen.3:15: Savior = God-Man.
- 4) Since Adam & Eve, how many babies have been born? Which one is the Savior? Has He ever been born yet?
- 5) Because God loves us, He tells us very clearly in His word who He is and how He will help us!
- 6) Adam and Eve had 2 sons. Cain and Able.
  - a) God began to teach them about the savior.
  - b) Sacrifice a lamb – tearing and blood.
  - c) Must remember 3 things. 1. Promise 2. Coming of the Savior 3. Accept the fact of being a sinner.
  - d) Cain's offering rejected because offered on his terms and not God's!
- 7) Seth takes place of Able.

NOTE: Emphasize 4 things: 1. Promise 2. Genealogy 3. Sacrifices 4. Prophecies.

- 8) Seth – Noah: God's judgment and mercy.
  - a) 120 years of preaching before being saved.
- 9) Noah had three sons. God chose Shem.
- 10) Shem to Abraham – (Father of many nations)
  - a) Sarah not able to have babies.
- 11) Gen. 12:2-3: Waits 25 years for fulfillment.
- 12) Gen. 15:4-6: Believed promise about the son therefore 'righteous'.
- 13) Gen. 15:13: Prophecy about going into slavery.
